#14 The Divided Kingdom

I. The surrounding kingdoms

- A. Assyria see Isa. 10:5. The major assault on Palestine came at the hands of the Tiglath-pileser II (744-727 BC). The credit for its fall goes to Sargon II (772-705). Shalmanesen V (726 722 BC) attacked Samaria.
- B. Egypt an almost forgotten nation during this time.
- C. Aramaea (Damascus) these states were to the north of Israel and were wiped out by Tiglath-pileser III. The language of Christ came from this part of the world.
- D. Babylon An alliance with the Median Kingdom resulted in the New-Babylonian Empire.
- E. Persia Judah fell at the hands of Nebuchadnezzar and Jerusalem was burnt down by his general, Nabuzaradan. A massive empire spread from Greece to India.


II. The two nations (1 Kings 12): Rehoboam & Jereboam

- A. The Northern Kingdom
 - 1. Also known as Israel or Ephraim
 - 2. Its capital was Samaria. There were two sanctuaries: Dan and Bethel
 - 3. 19 kings from Jeroboam (931-910 BC) to Hoshea (732-722 BC)
 - 4. Fell to the Assyrians in 722 BC (2 Kings 17:7-18)
- B. The Southern Kingdom
 - 1. Also knows as Judah
 - 2. Its capital was Jerusalem
 - 3. 20 kings from Rehoboam (931-913 BC) to Zedekiah (597-586 BC)
 - 4. Fell to the Babylonians in 586 BC (2 Kings 25:1-9)



Times of the Prophets



Israel's prophets are a built-in "reformation" aspect of Old Testament faith. The word "prophet" means "to speak out"—to forth-tell God's word as much as to foretell the future. They spoke out against hypocrisy, injustice, immorality and idolatry, warning God's people that He would punish them for such continued disobedience. The prophets also foretold the time when God would save a remnant of His people through whom all nations would be blessed.


