# Things to Come #14 The Fifth and Sixth Trumpets (Rev. 9:1-21)

## I. Introduction

With the blowing of the 5<sup>th</sup> trumpet, the judgment shifts away from the physical realm of life to the spiritual realm. Satan is raging a massive war against God, His holy angels and His people.

- A. Satan has a special hatred for Israel (1 Chron. 21:1) and the NT church (1 Pet. 5:8).
- B. He assaults believers before God (Rev. 12:10, Zech. 3:1)
- C. During the second half of the tribulation, he unleashes a torrid assault against the whole human race.

# II. The Fifth Trumpet (vs. 1-11): The First Woe

- A. The pit is unlocked
  - 1. "The star from heaven" this is an angelic being, likely Satan himself.

#### A word about the devil

This is an actual being, not just a force of evil. Satan has personality, will and intentionality.

#### His origin:

- He started as an anointed cherub (Eze. 28:12-19)
- His rebellion (with other angels) caused him to be cast out of heaven (Isa. 14:12-15)

## **His work:**

- He is a powerful enemy of God (Eph. 6:12) and loves to blind the eyes of men (2 Cor. 4:3-4)
- He is shrewd and cunning (Rev. 12:9) and uses those evil skills to temp the hearts of men (1 Thes. 3:5).
- He is wicked (1 John 3:8) and despises the Word of God (Mark 4:15)
- He loves to harass (1 Pet. 5:8) and accuse the believers (Rev. 12:10)

#### His "location":

He is fallen, but still has access to the throne room. (Rev. 12:10). And he moves around the world seeking to destroy believers.

<u>He is a master at disguise</u> (See 2 Cor. 11:13-15). He does not have a red suit and carry a pitchfork.

<u>He works with demons (unclean spirits, evil spirits)</u> – the hosts of wickedness in heavenly places (Eph. 6:12)

Some are free and roam the earth seeking the destruction of God's plan and His people (Luke 13:16).

Some are chained awaiting God's judgment (see Jude 6, 2 Pet. 2:4).

<u>His ultimate demise:</u> His head will ultimately be bruised (Gen. 3:15) and he will be cast into the lake of fire and brimstone (Matt. 24:51, Rev. 20:10).

2. The bottomless pit is opened and demons are released

## A word about hell

## **Sheol: Paradise** (see Luke 16:22-25)

- Note what Jesus did after His death: Eph. 4:8-10
- Those who trusted in the coming Messiah went to Paradise with Christ.

#### **Sheol: Hades**

- Peter calls it Tartarus: 2 Pet. 2:4 (he was using a term out of Greek mythology)
- Jesus used a term for hell out of the Jewish vernacular (Gehenna).
   Refers to a ravine south of Jerusalem where Hebrew parents had sacrificed children to the Ammonite god (2 Kings 16:3, 2 Chron. 28:1-3). It became the city dump that burned day and night "the lake of fire"
- Hades is the present day hell. Unsaved souls go there, suffer in torment until the time of the Great White Throne Judgment
- It is also the "holding cell" for some demons.

## The final hell

- A place of outer darkness, everlasting punishment. (Matt 13:42)
- The final "home" for Satan, his demons, and the unsaved from all ages (including those who survive the Tribulation). See Rev. 20:10
- a. These vile demons take on the form of locusts. They are swarming with their destruction. For 5 months, they inflict incredible pain likened to that of a scorpion bite. The cannot touch those who have the seal of God on their foreheads (see Rev. 3:13 and Eze. 9:4-6)
- b. These demonic creatures "appear like" horses prepared for battle: their mission is to hurt people.
- c. The angel of the abyss: Abaddon (means destruction or ruin) Appollyon (means "I destroy"). This is either Satan himself or an emissary of his choosing.

# III. The Sixth Trumpet (vs. 13-12): The Second Woe

A. The river Euphrates

Runs from the mountains in Turkey to the Persian Gulf. Location of the Garden of Eden (Gen. 2:14), was the eastern boundary of the Promised Land (Gen. 15:18), the enemies of God will cross over this river to begin the battle of Armageddon (Rev. 16:12-16)

- B. The Four Angels: demonic forces that will serve as instruments of divine judgment.
- C. They will kill a third of the world's population. 7.4 Billion people on earth right now.
- D. The armies of the horsemen: 200 million strong

  Note that their colors are features of hell (see 14:10, 19:20)
- E. The rest of mankind does not repent
  - 1. They continue to worship demons and idols (see Deut. 4:28, Ps. 115:5-7)
  - 2. They are murderers (Ex. 20:13)
  - 3. They participate in sorcery (a word that means pharmaceuticals)
  - 4. They are immoral ("Porneia")
  - 5. They are guilty of thefts

# IV.So What?

Consider Eph. 5:3-7 <sup>18</sup> But among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity, or of greed, because these are improper for God's holy people. <sup>4</sup> Nor should there be obscenity, foolish talk or coarse joking, which are out of place, but rather thanksgiving. <sup>5</sup> For of this you can be sure: No immoral, impure or greedy person—such a person is an idolater—has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God. <sup>[a]</sup> <sup>6</sup> Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of such things God's wrath comes on those who are disobedient. <sup>7</sup> Therefore do not be partners with them."

Who are we partners with?
